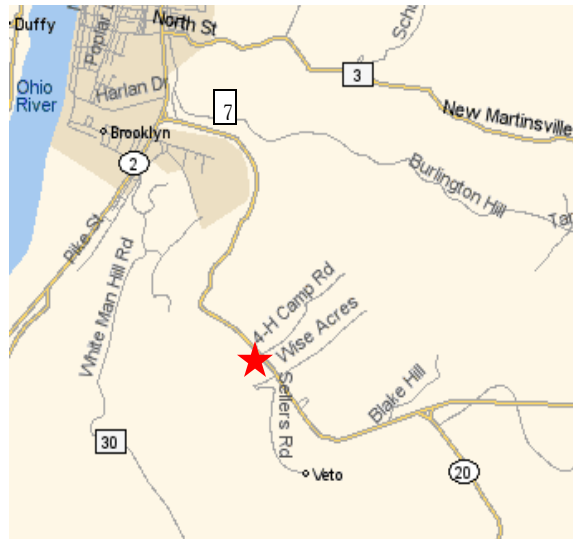


# Wetzel County Commission

## The Mollohan Conference and Training Center

is an 8,000-square-foot facility designed to host a wide variety of activities and programs. The facility offers a 5,500-square-foot banquet and assembly hall for wedding receptions and parties as well as large group training and educational events. An 800-square-foot conference room is located at the back of the center separated from the assembly hall by a 600-square-foot commercial kitchen. The center is heated and air conditioned for year-round programming.



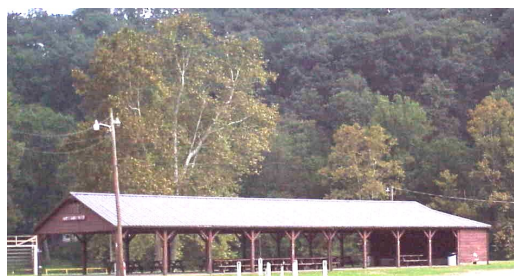
## 150 Campsites and Shower House Facilities

have been developed with water and electrical hook-ups. A dump station has recently been added on site. With the addition of the shower house and rest room facilities, our campgrounds are now ready to host campers in a quiet, rustic, county environment close enough to town for shopping or dining out.



## Three Shelters and Picnic

areas are available for reunions, parties and family gatherings. Two smaller shelters seat approximately 50 people and one large shelter seats 130 people.



## The 40-acre campgrounds

are open recreational fields which provide youth a great deal of open space to run. The property is located next to Big Fishing Creek which provides fishing and boating opportunities. A Stage is also located on the facility for concerts and community activities.
